PROJECT DESCRIPTION: PROJECT OBJECTIVE: A project targeted to the youth and adults of our church community in Upland (Upland/Ontario/Rancho Cucamonga neighborhood). We will use our young people who are in the middle school / high school levels to reach out to their classmates / schoolmates to join. We will also visit homes in the community informing them of our sports programs and ask them to join the tennis lessons and games for free. In doing this, we want to address minimizing youth be engaged to drug and other delinquent-related activities by engaging them into sports. We do not limit to the youth, we will also offer it to the adults and children with their parents who would like to learn and continue to play tennis. We target to have three meetings a week on Sundays (either morning or afternoon), Tuesdays and Thursdays (after school afternoon). TARGET GROUP: Middle school / high school level youth, Children and parents and other adults

HOW WILL THE PLAN BE ORGANIZED AND IMPLEMENTED: We will start with our own youth / pathfinders to teach them the game of tennis and have experience the game themselves. Then we will organize our youth / pathfinders to do the initial informal survey among their classmates and friends those who are interested in playing tennis. We will also visit homes in the community with our flyers about free tennis program of our church for youth, children with parents, and adults. Our church has three persons that are tennis coaches and are willing to do the teaching/coaching work. We will ask volunteers to be able to help as sponsors and provide the assistance for bringing the tennis gadgets to and from the tennis court; serve as sponsors and bring the water and snacks and medical kit to the court. In every schedule, coaches and sponsors have to be in the court to serve as help and or just plain sponsors.

EXPECTED RESULTS: Those people in the community that would and could get involved in this tennis program will become friends to the church specially to the coaches and volunteers on these tennis activities. Two of our coaches are elders and the third coach is the pastor. Through our friendship and socialization with these people, children, youth and adults, will come to know us and the church more. It would be easier to invite them to come during visitor's Sabbath or special occasion of the church and even to invite them to study the Bible with them.


Right now we have an elderly Roman Catholic person helping us weekly in the food bank ministry of the church for several months now. He was an acquaintance from the tennis court.
