

1. **Bible workers** need assistance in housing, transportation to do visitation and meals. \$25,000.00.
2. **Evangelistic set-up:** Tent rental and chairs, landscaping, transporting organ and piano, setting up of electricity, wiring building, platform, portable baptismal pool, exit signs, fire extinguisher, property rental. \$15,000.00.
3. **Gift.** Bible and home appliances, iPad, Bible studies, small group Bible studies, step down program. \$10,000.00.
4. **Cancer Screening:** E.g., Prostate and Breast Cancer; Diabetes and High Blood Pressure Screening: \$10,000.00.
5. **Block Party:** \$2,000.00.

Objective:

Saving men, women, boys and girls who are non-Adventist and non-church goers through Bible studies and small groups. We will implement Friendship Evangelism where each member is responsible for a new member. We will train and have workshops to train our members to do outreach. We want to meet the needs of our community spiritually and the setting up of a grand Sabbath School.

How will the plans be implemented?

We are going to have Bible workers visiting the target area six weeks before the meeting. We are going to get Bibles and the conflict series. We will have a few revival and seminars leading up to the meeting. We are having a special day called Friendship Day where everyone is responsible for bringing five (5) non-Adventist friends to church. The idea is that these individuals will be ready for baptism by the time of the Crusade.

Target Groups:

Educated professionals who have no denominational affiliation. Also, we welcome everyone from the educated to the non-educated. Those in Corporate America and Blue Collar Workers; the rich, the poor and middle class. The Gospel does not discriminate, so I won't either. Whoever the Lord sends our way we will accept. Whosoever will may come!

We want a large harvest and immediately we are going to put these new members to work and they too will be trained to be Fishers of Men.
