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PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

One of the strongest departments in our church and the one many of our members are deeply passionate about is our health department. One of the greatest needs in our community is for dedicated and outstanding health workers to be acknowledged. And also for individuals to see the need to prioritize their health needs as integral to their over all well being. The countless hours spent off the clock by nurses and others in the health care industry often goes unnoticed and unrewarded. Also the failing health of many of the families in the community continues to be a great burden on their finances and add stress to their lives.

At the Winnemucca SDA church we have a desire to change that. Our outreach team and the health department wants to create a week long evangelistic campaign that focusses on health and includes ways to acknowledge and award health workers in our city.

Our campaign would be launched on a Sunday with a community health fair where health businesses, that are aligned with our values, would join us and set up booths and have give aways. Our church would provide refreshments for the event.

At this health fair we would have an award ceremony where we will acknowledge the outstanding health care workers that have made an impact on the lives of people in our community. This would be followed up with a mini week long evangelistic campaign and health work shops.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE:

We endeavor to practically illustrate how the health message and the advent truths are closely aligned. Our prayer is that our outreach would show our community how the gospel can improve their day to day lives.

TARGET GROUP:

We hope to reach 75 families in the vicinity of the church and connect with 50 health professionals throughout the city of Winnemucca and their families.

HOW THE PLAN WILL BE ORGANIZED AND IMPLEMENTED:

- Between April 1 and 15 our members will contact the health businesses in the community and invite them to set up booths at our health fair.
- We will also connect with our local hospitals and local physicians to recommend their outstanding workers.
- On Sunday the 19th of May we will hold a six hour health fair which ends with an award ceremony. At this ceremony we will acknowledge and award the community's outstanding workers. They will receive plaques and books that illustrate the connections between our fundamentals and the health message. Our hope is that each awardee would be accompanied by four to six friends coworkers and family. With our church getting an opportunity to minister to over three to four hundred unchurched and non-Adventist individuals.
- Our evangelist would be the master of ceremony and would splice in biblical health concepts along with the giving of the awards. And also give a sneak peek of the topics that will be covered in the up coming evangelistic campaign.
- The awardees would be invited to our successful people seminar from Wednesday to Sabbath of the same week. This is a mini evangelistic campaign where we will teach the fundamentals from a motivational and health standpoint. The power of rest and the sabbath. The promise of lasting peace of mind and the second coming. No more anxiety and the state of the dead.
- Prior to each seminar we would hold a health work shop conducted by one of the organizations from the community who participated in the health fair.
- To help fund this weekend, and to be able to partner with the community in this endeavor, we will invite businesses within the community, particularly those that specialize in health related businesses and products, to sponsor the plaques.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

We expect to reach 300 to 500 non-adventist through our health fair and award ceremony. We pray that between 100 and 150 would attend our mini evangelism that week. We hope to begin Bible studies from this effort and pray that many would be convicted and become members of God's remnant church.
